The prevalence of internet addiction in various categories was 1.6% normal, 47.4% mild, 38.1% moderate, and 12.9% severe. Our analysis also showed a significantly higher proportion of senior students with severe internet addiction (16.4%) compared to junior students ($\chi^2 = 30.964$; $p < 0.001$).

The prevalence of Internet addiction in American college students is 12% and the Internet addiction rate of Iranian medical students is 10.8% [3, 4]. Worse yet, studies have shown that the rate of Internet addiction in Serbian schoolchildren is 18.7% [5].

Internet addiction detection rate among college students ...

Internet addiction was present in 59.1% of the individuals who reported most gaming, while prevalence among those who did not use the internet for gaming was 44.4% ($p = 0.010$). Among subjects with IA, 70.3% used the internet to access pornographic content, while 47.4% of subjects who accessed this type of content did not have IA.
